Referral Process

Referral partners may contact Civara Recovery to discuss potential resident placement. All residents complete an intake screening to ensure appropriate program placement.

Typical referral sources include:

- Treatment centers
- Probation and parole officers
- Courts and diversion programs
- Recovery organizations
- Self-referrals

Reporting & Communication with Partners

When appropriate and authorized, Civara Recovery can provide documentation or updates to referral partners regarding resident participation and progress.

- Residency verification
- Program compliance updates
- Employment progress documentation
- Discharge or transition planning

Civara Recovery Operates as a Self-pay Sober Living Residence

The cost of residency is **\$200 per week**, which includes housing and utilities. Residents are responsible for providing their own food and personal items.

Insurance is not accepted.
